Objectives

Session 1: Camera Ready

Topics

- Overview of the series and training modules
- Introductions - Each participant tells a story about greatest challenges of on-line presentation to various cultures
- Your demeanor: Visual delivery components and tips
- Voice enhancements to consider for on-line delivery: Adding animation to your voice (with practice exercises)
- Composure and readiness: Managing your energy for presentations; maintaining poise under pressure
- Different virtual meeting roles, and what each entails (discussion of what is expected by Experian and what is expected by client audiences)
- Initial Culture Map takeaways and objectives for Session Two
- Homework assignment: Prepare to present 3 minutes from a current presentation. Also, prepare a question from your materials that can be discussed in a breakout session.

Session 2: Increasing Engagement

Topics

- Culture Map: Awareness and adjusting to different cultures
- Setting the stage effectively for audience involvement
- Identifying the most effective ways to add involvement in your sessions:
Introduction to questioning techniques
- Advanced interactive and technical skills (guidelines for chats, breakouts, discussions, with practice)
- Practice exercises with potential breakouts: Each person delivers a component of their presentation and adds an audience involvement tool, then receives feedback from the consultant and the group
- Homework assignments: Identify a new example/story for a culture that is different than your own

Session 3: Advanced Topics

Topics

- How audience members view their roles and behavioural expectations based on their culture
- Meeting management: Redirecting when necessary
- Involvement Skills
 - Questioning techniques: When and how to use them
 - Types of questions and how each type fits your role as presenter/facilitator
 - Culture Map: How the Persuasion Scale affects the types of questions you receive from various audience members
- Breakouts
 - Discussion on Culture Map implications for future learning
 - Learning Action plans, and how the team can reinforce each other
